

**Ngee Ann Polytechnic  
Admission for Academic Year 2025 Intake  
Entrance Test Information**

- 1) The entrance test will be jointly organised by the five polytechnics. Shortlisted candidates are required to choose **only one Polytechnic as the entrance test administrator**.
- 2) Shortlisted candidates will receive an email invitation from the Ngee Ann Polytechnic Entrance Test Administrator by December 2024, to sit for the entrance test held in end January/early February 2025.
- 3) The entrance test will be held **online** and the duration of each subject paper is **90 minutes**. Shortlisted candidates may take the online entrance test using their own laptop, at their own venue (For Example: your own home). Detailed instructions on what to prepare for this online entrance test will be provided by the Polytechnic you have chosen as the entrance test administrator.
- 4) All subject papers for English, Mathematics and Science will be scheduled within the same day. The same test paper for each subject will be used across all Polytechnic and will be held at the same time. Candidates will be given sufficient breaks between papers. Your test results will be shared among the Polytechnics who have invited you for the entrance test.
- 5) Shortlisted candidates are required to pay an administrative fee of Singapore Dollars \$40.00 (subject to the prevailing GST) for each subject paper. Payment instructions will be provided by the Polytechnic you have chosen as the entrance test administrator.
- 6) Ngee Ann Polytechnic courses are categorized into **4 Aggregate Types**:
  - A:** Humanities & Media related courses
  - B:** Business related courses
  - C:** Science & Technology related courses
  - D:** Design related courses

7) Details of each subject papers are as follows.

a) **English\*** (Required for ALL Courses)

\*Candidates may be exempted from sitting for the English paper if they have obtained any of the following English Language proficiency minimum scores, **please include this document in your DAE application** for verification if you wish to be exempted from the English Paper:

- IELTS Academic minimum overall score of 6.0, with minimum score of 6.0 each individual assessment components of Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking
- TOEFL Internet-Based Test with minimum score of 78
- IGCSE English as a First Language with minimum grade C
- Year 12 English Language subject minimum score of 70% from any of these native English-speaking countries : USA, Canada, Australia & New Zealand

b) **Mathematics** (Required for ALL Courses – No Exemptions)

c) **Science\*\*** (Only required for Aggregate Type C courses from this list i.e. Engineering/Science/Science-related/IT courses)

\*\*Candidates may **choose one out of three available Science subjects** they want to sit for:

- Biology
- Chemistry
- Physics
