Accept Course Offer & Complete Course Registration

- Login to <u>My Enrolment</u> with your **NP Email Address** and **Password**.
- Go to Course Reg. & Fees Payment.
- Verify your course offer by clicking 'Accept' at the Course Reg. & Fees Payment.
- Complete all sections (there are up to 9) of the course registration!
 Can't finish? Click Save as draft and come back later.
- Check all information is correct before clicking '**Confirm Registration**'. You'll receive a confirmation message when it is done.
- Remember to complete your course registration by the deadline stated in your Acceptance of Offer letter!

Unable to commence studies in 2025 due to NS?

- o Go to the Course Offer & Acceptance page. Click 'Defer'.
- Upload the completed
 Request Form for Deferment of
 Commencement of Studies.
 You will need to include
 documentary proof from MINDEF.



o If this is your first time enrolling at a polytechnic, your place will be reserved, and you'll get a **confirmation** email by August 2025.



Upload Photo for Student Card and Diploma Student Concession Card

- Login to <u>My Enrolment</u>.
- Go to Photo Upload and upload a recent passportstandard photo.
- The photo should be coloured with a white background. Check that it meets these guidelines.
- Use these <u>tips on how to resize the photo</u> if needed.

Diploma Student Concession Card (optional)

- The Student & Alumni Services Office (SAS) will send the application instructions to your <u>NP connect email</u> if your uploaded photo meets the <u>guidelines</u>. Follow the instructions in the email.

- If you enrolled after mid-March, check your eligibility for a concession card via <u>SimplyGo</u>. Your eligibility will be updated about 15 working days after you complete the course registration.

When and How to apply for Financial Schemes?

Check your <u>NP connect email</u> between March to April 2025 for information on how to apply for financial schemes (PSEA, Mendaki, CPF or MOE Tuition Fee Loan).



Details on financial schemes can be found <u>here</u> and at the table on page 11.

Remember! Pay your fees before the Due Date stated on your e-Fee voucher.

You can use PayNow, credit/debit card, bank transfer or at the designated OCBC branches. Payment status will be updated after 3 working days.

Want to be considered for a bursary (MOE-Financial Assistance Scheme)? Indicate this at the '**Fees Payment**' page. Details about the process will be sent to your <u>NP connect email</u> when the application opens.

Payment Mode 1:

PayNow QR Code

- o Set up your PayNow account by linking your mobile number and/or Singapore NRIC/FIN to the bank account (if you have not done so).
- o Ensure the maximum limit for PayNow transfers is sufficient to make payment. The amount is similar to your daily local transfer limit.
- o Login to My Enrolment.
- o Go to Course Reg. & Fees Payment and select 'Fees Payment'. Follow on-screen instructions.
- o Scan the PayNow QR code using your mobile banking app.

Payment Mode 2:

Debit or Credit Card

- o Login to <u>My Enrolment</u>.
- Go to Course Reg. & Fees Payment and select 'Fees Payment'.
 Follow on-screen instructions. Record the payment reference as proof of payment.

Payment Mode 3:

Fund Transfer

- o Transfer to NP OCBC bank account number 518-715297-001.
- o Include your Student ID for reference (e.g. 1027XXXA).

Payment Mode 4:

Cash

- Deposit the cash at any OCBC bank branch, into Ngee Ann Polytechnic's OCBC account 518-715297-001.
- Include your Student ID (e.g. 1027XXXA) for reference on the deposit slip, and retain the deposit slip as proof of payment.

Cheque

- o Make cheque payable to **Ngee Ann Polytechnic**.
- Include NP's OCBC bank account number 518-715297-001, your Student ID (e.g. 1027XXXXA), and contact number on the back of the cheque.
- o Drop the cheque into any OCBC quick cheque deposit box.



Submit Enrolment Forms

Submit Parent / Guardian Acknowledgement Form (COMPULSORY)

You need to do this if you are below 21 years old as of 2 January 2025.

- **Download**, print and complete the form.
- Upload the signed form via <u>My Enrolment</u> within 3 days from the Course Registration deadline stated in your 'Acceptance of Offer' letter.

Submit Financial Forms

A. Submit Application for GIRO Deduction (COMPULSORY)

All students are required to pay their school fees through GIRO.

- **Covered by financial schemes?** Applying for GIRO is a must! It's the best way to ensure your fees are fully covered for your entire course at NP.
- DBS/POSB/OCBC account holders (with internet banking)?
 Login to <u>My Enrolment</u>, go to <u>Compulsory Forms</u> and select <u>Application for GIRO Deduction</u> to submit an online Application for GIRO Deduction.
- NON DBS/POSB/OCBC GIRO account holders or DBS/POSB/OCBC accounts without internet banking? Login to <u>My Enrolment</u>, go to <u>Compulsory Forms</u> and select **Application for GIRO Deduction** to complete and submit the form to Finance Office, Ngee Ann Polytechnic, 535, Clementi Road, Singapore 599489.

B. Complete the GIRO Direct Credit Application (COMPULSORY)

The GIRO Direct Credit Application allows the Polytechnic to reimburse or pay you via GIRO whenever necessary.

• Login to <u>My Enrolment</u>, go to Compulsory Forms and select **GIRO Direct Credit Application** to submit the online application, together with a copy of your bank statement or passbook.

Class Timetable and other Student E- Services

- Login with your **NP email address** and **password**.
- You can also access your class or exam timetable, exam results and more via the NP Go! App.



Student's Pass (for International Students only)

- All International Students must apply for the Student's Pass (STP) upon completion of course enrolment. Please refer to the <u>STP application guide</u> for more information.
- Dependant's Pass (DP) Holders should check <u>here</u> for follow-up action.

Financial Schemes



- Sign up between March to April 2025.
- All schemes listed can be used to pay for full-time diploma tuition fees. However they do not cover
 other fees payable in the first semester of each academic year (except the PSEA scheme). The approved
 scheme(s) will be effective throughout your course of study at NP unless you revoke them
 in writing, or there is insufficient fund balance.
- We will notify you in mid-June if there are any balance fees payable after processing the various financial schemes.
- Are you a PFP student?*

You're only eligible to apply for Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA). Financial schemes listed do not apply to you.

Permanent Residents and International students
 You must submit the Tuition Grant deed with MOE before applying for financial schemes. Students
 eligible for the MOE Tuition Grant are required to attend a briefing in April 2025 to find out more.
 Applications will open in May 2025. More information will be sent to your <u>NP connect email</u> nearer the date.

Tertiary Tuition Fee Subsidy for Malay Students (Administered by Yayasan MENDAKI)*

- This scheme is for all eligible Malay students with Per Capita Income (PCI) of \$2,000 or less.
- Only online applications will be accepted. Apply at the <u>My Mendaki Portal</u>.

SkillsFuture Credit (for students aged 25 and above)*

This scheme is for all Singaporean students aged 25 and above.

• Apply online using Singpass. Submit your claims via <u>MySkillsFuture</u> within 60 days before the course start date.

Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA)

This scheme is for all Singaporean students or students with Singaporean siblings who have balances in their PSEA accounts.

• <u>Submit your application online</u> to use funds in your own or your siblings' PSEA account. If you are above 21 years of age, please login with your own Singpass. If you are below 21 years old, your parent or legal guardian must complete the form on your behalf.

CPF Education Loan Scheme*

This scheme is for all full-time Singaporean and Permanent Resident students. You can apply to use your own or your parents' CPF Ordinary Account savings (capped at 40% of OA savings).

- Apply online at the <u>CPF website</u> using Singpass. Please ensure the CPF account member endorses the application within 14 days of submission.
- Please note that this loan scheme does not apply to PFP students.

MOE Tuition Fee Loan*

This scheme is for all full-time diploma students. The loan covers up to 75% of tuition fees.

- Apply online at the <u>DBS website</u>. Please refer to the <u>DBS website</u> for the list of required supporting documents and guide to obtaining digibank access.
- Your guarantor must be a Singapore Citizen (SC) for SC students; SC or Singapore Permanent Resident (PR) for PR and International students, and between the ages of 21 and 60 years old. In addition, they must not be an undischarged bankrupt.
