

The Compassionate Innovator

An innovator with heart, En Yang fuses his tech brilliance with a passion to serve.

The Information Technology graduate has worked on groundbreaking projects, such as inventing a now Singapore-patented platform for our healthcare system that combines AI and cybersecurity testing. His ingenious inventions landed him the National Youth Entrepreneurship Award, as well as induction into the Philip Yeo Innovation Fellows Programme. An advocate for youth social leadership, En Yang fosters innovation and entrepreneurship amongst students from lower-income backgrounds, through his role as SG Country Director for the Young Founders Summit. The curious self-starter has also served as the Japan Outreach Director in the Lee Kuan Yew Global Business Plan Competition, where he led a delegation to four Japanese cities to invite start-ups and investors to bring foreign investments into Singapore. En Yang has also been offered multiple scholarships and has been accepted into the Masayoshi Son Foundation, which supports youth with high aspirations and exceptional talents.




Tan Kiok Wei Daryl, Lifesaving Club
